


What is Happiness?


The 4 Levels of Happiness






Level 1: Animal Happiness (Laetus)

- Fulfilment of appetite
- Material objects
- Transient!



Level 2: Comparison (Felix)

- Ego gratification
- 'The Comparison Game'
- Compare ourselves to others
- Can be good, but only last so long!



Level 3: Doing Good (*Beatitudo*)



- Based on goodness, compassion, love
- Leads to good in the world usually
- But, comes to and end as well
- Boils down to being about us



Diagnosing the Problem






1. When people have plenty to eat, they turn to thinking great thoughts!

2. We need to make sure of our physical survival <u>before</u> we can do serious thinking

3. Having satisfied their physical hunger, people become aware of a deeper kind of hunger – a longing for something that will <u>really satisfy.</u>






What About Money & Fame?


