- Materialism (only the physical stuff nothing more)






## **Confusion: What is God?**


- The Reason why there is something rather than nothing.
- The spaceless, timeless, all powerful, personal, Cause of the universe and everything in it.


#### The Limits of Science

• God & Science are not competing






#### Fine Tuning of the Universe for Life


 The conditions that allow for life to exist are <u>extremely</u> improbable




#### Science Points to a Designer


## Science Doesn't Answer the Biggest Questions of Life

His biology and his belief in naturalism would therefore appear to be at war with each other in a conflict that has nothing at all to do with God" - Alvin Plantinga
